

SCHOLARSHIPS

LYDIA AND MARK SCHOLARSHIPS

This \$750 scholarship is awarded to returning female and male students who have been full-time students the past two semesters at IBCS, have maintained at least a 2.0 grade point average while at IBCS, have demonstrated personal industry, have demonstrated a spirit of serving others, and have demonstrated a financial need.

DR. DAVID C. SPROUL SCHOLARSHIP

The Dr. David C. Sproul Scholarship for Missions and Evangelism is a \$750 scholarship awarded to a returning student who has been a full-time student the past two semesters at IBCS, has demonstrated a heart for international missions and evangelism, has maintained at least a 3.0 grade point average while at IBCS, and has demonstrated a financial need.

JOSEPH SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship, with the amount being determined annually, is given in memory of Joseph Merrill, Jr. to a junior or senior who exemplifies a spirit of service, humility, integrity, and faithfulness.

STANLEY L. BUSHEY BIBLICAL LANGUAGES SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship has been established in memory of Dr. Stanley L. Bushey, former faculty member of IBCS. The \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to an undergraduate or graduate student taking intermediate or more advanced Greek or Hebrew and has maintained a 3.0 grade point average.

DR. JERRY C. TETREAU EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship has been established to honor the legacy of IBCS's cofounder, Dr. Jerry Charles Tetreau, and is awarded regularly to an education student who exhibits frugality, industry, humility, and a desire to pursue lifelong learning.

CHANCELLOR'S SCHOLARSHIPS

These \$750 scholarships are awarded annually to both a returning female and male undergraduate student who have been full-time students the past two semesters at IBCS, have maintained at least a 2.0 grade point average while at IBCS, have demonstrated personal industry, have demonstrated a spirit of serving others, and have demonstrated a financial need.

FOUNDER'S SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship has been established in memory of IBCS founder, Dr. James Singleton, founding pastor of Tri-City Baptist Church. The \$1000 scholarship is awarded to a returning student who will be enrolled as a Junior or Senior, is pursuing a Bachelor's degree in Christian Service, has maintained at least a 2.5 grade point average, and is enrolled in at least six credit hours.

FOUNDER'S POST-GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship has been established in memory of IBCS founder, Dr. James Singleton, founding pastor of Tri-City Baptist Church. The \$750 scholarship is awarded to a graduate student who is pursuing a Master of Ministry, Master of Christian Education, or Doctor of Ministry degree and who has maintained at least a 3.0 grade point average.

DEPARTMENT HEAD AWARDS

AN EXPLANATION OF ACADEMIC REGALIA

HOOD

The length and subtle details of the hood indicate the degree earned.

- The doctor's hood is quite long, has two tails, and has a fiveinch-wide velvet.
- The master's hood is shorter than the doctor's and has a threeinch-wide velvet.
- The bachelor's hood is shorter than the master's and has a twoinch-wide velvet.

The color of the hood indicates the field of study in which the degree was earned.

- Black or Blue Velvet Trim Doctor of Philosophy
- White Velvet Trim Master of Arts
- Drab Business
- Light Blue Education
- Lemon Library Sciences
- Pink Music
- Salmon Public Health
- Scarlet Religion

The lining of the hood are the colors of the school from the graduate's *alma mater*.

GOWN

The President's gown is distinguished by four velvet panels on each sleeve.

The doctor's gown has two distinguishing features:

- The gown is much fuller than the bachelor's or the master's gown.
- It has three velvet panels on the sleeves, as well as velvet around the neck and down the front.

The distinguishing feature of the master's gown is the tippet sleeve.

TASSEL

The color of the tassels and the velvet on the gowns indicates the field of study in which the degree was earned.
